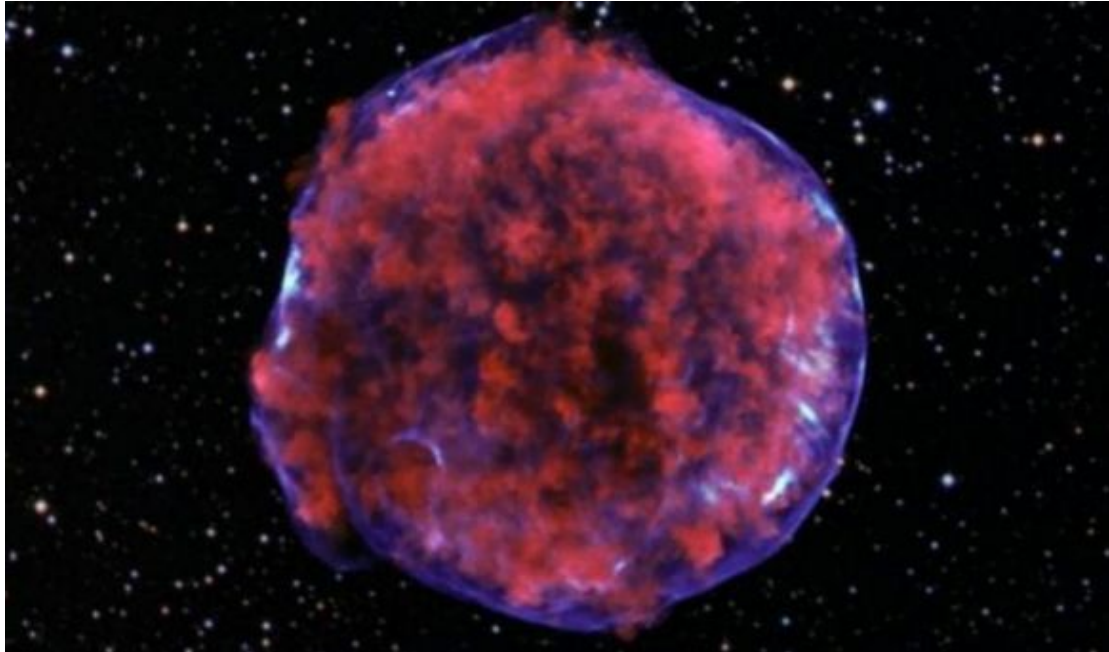

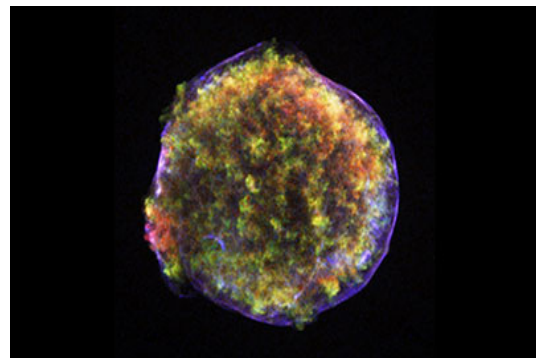
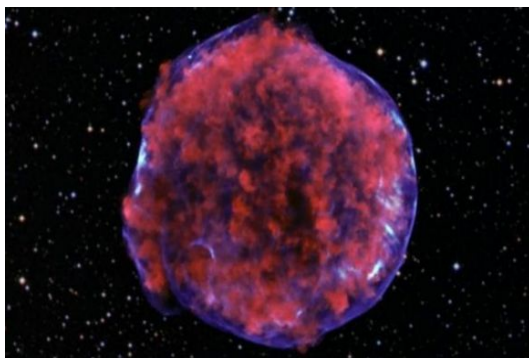
Abstract: showing an image of a visible neutrinos agglomerate body
