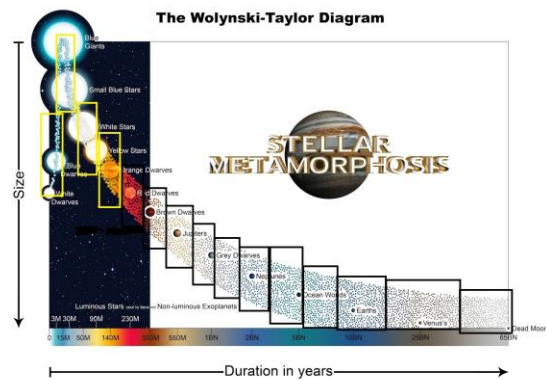

Abstract: Establishment dogma has a false worldview, they have justified compartmentalization of stars with classification based on mass. Stars were classified to be mutually exclusive of planets/exoplanets, yet a star is a young hot exoplanet/planet. The stars lose mass as they evolve.
