Abstract

In the September 11, 2001, nearly 3000 U.S. citizens were killed by terror attacks. A strong relationship existed between Palestinians, Qut bists, and jihadist groups with the Iranian government. Those days, Islamism in Europe had made strong connections with some Arabs and also Iranians. So, for example the al-Quds Mosque in Hamburg was not such an exception. There some attackers attended and met one another, forming the Hamburg cell. Al-Qaeda is an advocate of jihad. We consider Iran as a powerful propagator of radicalism mindset. In Afghanistan a series of meetings occurred in spring of 1999, involving Sheikh Mohammed, and Osama bin Laden. Atta became involved with the al-Quds Mosque. The Quds Force is described as "a military branch of Iran, active in dozens of countries". It is estimated, Iranians have at least hundreds of thousands of military troops just in Syria, Lebanon, Iraq, etc. Here we shall investigate the real causes of this brutal terrorist attack. In addition to a memorial, built at Ground Zero, other memorials have been built across the U.S. such as Flight 93 National Memorial, and Pentagon Memorial, following the terrorist attacks. Construction of the National September 11 Memorial & Museum began in August 2006. And it was opened to the general public in 2014. Just after the attacks President George W. Bush called it as "despicable acts of terror". Today we are trying hard to stand against the will of terrorists. Relatives of victims of the attacks won't ever forget such violations against humanity.

Terrorism groups by involvement in suicide attacks or patrol missions have posed a security threat to civil societies for long periods of time. The Iranian government is holding the fourth-largest proven oil reserves.[2] Our troops, fighting for freedom, substantially in the 21st century are confronted to potential threats. We are confronted to instable behaviors, and to some form of insurgent groups. And we are surrounded by coercive persuasion industries. Via a remarkably cogent review of the deadliest terrorist attack on the American soil (to date) we would gain a better understanding of the politics and government of many countries of the Middle East. Following the incident, the international community strikingly expressed great solicitude to the relatives of the victims of this mass murder attack. A total of 2,977 people's lives lost by terror attacks by several U.S. oppositions, in the September 11, 2001. It's a heavy duty to make a brief but well organized proposition in regard with the intelligence operation behind the attack. One of the attacks caused the collapse of the twin towers (2192 civilians in and around the towers died) when 2 airplanes crashed to the building. We would take a look over the issue. But furthermore it would come up over a few years for people to perceive how violent and scandalous the attack was. A system which needs more public attention to get heard by a variety of people. The attacks consisted of suicide attacks used to target symbolic U.S. landmarks. Four passenger airliners were hijacked by 19 al-Qaeda terrorists to be flown into buildings. The United States responded to the attacks by launching the War on Terror and invading Afghanistan to depose the Taliban, which had harbored al-Qaeda. Bin Laden's family traces its origins to Awad bin Laden from the village of Al Rubat, in the Wadi Doan in the Tarim Valley, Hadramout governorate, Yemen. A few members of his family were not engaged in military activities. A few were working on trade industry, art, etc. The financial interests of the bin Laden family are represented by the Saudi Binladin Group, a global oil and equity management conglomerate grossing \$2 billion annually, and the largest construction firm in the world, with offices in London, Dubai and Geneva. Bin Laden had made business in jihad, war against the west, and trading the Islamic industry. Joint Iranian terrorists and some Arabian riot groups are getting considered as almost the only attackers of those nations who (over cooperation with al-Qaeda of Afghanistan) attacked the United States in the 9/11. Although Iran had not been such an anti-Soviet (USSR) government much, none of the other supporters of the attackers were belonging to the groups or countries who had not made relationships (or meetings) with Soviets behind the closed doors at least (here you can consider the USSR as the Russians), except that Afghanistan was seriously against the Soviets. Iranian students over the curse of Islamic studies, and also in a few national TV shows learn that such countries (a union of the well-known current rulers for the security

of the world) should get considered as a few of the great powers or (especially in regard with the U.S. and Israel) the Satans. In formal literatures only the U.S. is described as the Great Satan. However the attackers made up their plans, and got effectively headed to the targets, in the September 11th. After burning for 56 minutes, the South Tower collapsed at 9:59 A.M. At 10:28 A.M., the North Tower collapsed, after burning for 102 minutes. The attacks on the World Trade Center killed 2,753 people in total. Our hope for fighting terrorism isn't fell down near the shores of New York harbor. In 1979, the then Soviet Union invades Afghanistan. In 1980, Soviet troops set up a puppet regime in Kabul, the Afghan capital. The US, Pakistan, China, Iran and Saudi Arabia offer support to (the eastern guerrilla) anti-communist Muslim Afghan fighters who opposed the Soviet occupation of Afghanistan. In 1988, the Soviet Union withdraws after 15,000 Soviet soldiers die in the conflict. In 1994, the battles reduce much of Kabul to rubble. Mullah Mohammed Omar, a Muslim cleric, sets up Taliban movement of Islamic students who take up arms, capture Kandahar and advance on Kabul. In 1996, Osama bin Laden, al-Qaeda's leader who (we can say alongside many of 'the Afghan Mujahideen' groups) fought against the Soviet occupation, returns to Afghanistan. The Taliban takes Kabul and hangs former President Mohammad Najibullah. The Iranian wishes towards abolishing the Ba'athist Iraq that had threatened the Iranian's government over Iran-Iraq war and the struggle between Shias and Sunnies (the 9/11 attackers were mostly identified as Sunni Muslims) have made an ideological dispersion in the Middle East. A few of several other countries which had engaged in the Operation Desert Storm before, didn't feel guilty not to supporting the possessions side. A well understandable relationship party between Palestine and jihadist groups such as Hezbollah with Iran had been and yet is existed. However I shall mention that the terrorists were from Saudi Arabia, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, etc. Islamic figures such as Muhammad and Hussain, whether successful or not, always tried to bring justice to people. Imams didn't fight against each other. Following the last era for some reasons Iran is trying to colonize Shi'ism in the Middle East. It's a powerful country in ICT, and powerful enough in nuclear technology. Following the fall of Saddam Hussein, Iraq became a Shia nation, and many mosques for the Shia minorities more freely are being operated in Afghanistan (following the fall of bin Laden, and also a fatal shock on the Taliban). Most of the population of Afghanistan is made of Sunni people. Nevertheless terrorism ideology makes the main body of such jihadist and terror actions itself, but it is crucial to mention that such coordinated plans made a drift and less-fundamental mindset for some believers in the virtual face of Islam, which feeds people with the culture of jihad against the United States and also Israel. Thus more than a few infrastructures were crashed by 4 hijacked airplanes which 3 of them could reach their planned targets by al-Qaeda. The Iranian government had a moderately secretive connection with al-Qaeda. It is said U.S. trained only some al-Qaeda members, but allegedly al-Qaeda and Iran formed an alliance during the 1990s in which Hezbollah trained al-Qaeda operatives.[9] Mohammed Atta was an Egyptian, little known

in regard with him. Atta studied architecture at Cairo University, graduating in 1990, and continued his studies in Germany at the Hamburg University of Technology. In Hamburg, Atta became involved with the al-Quds Mosque, where he met Marwan al-Shehhi, Ramzi bin al-Shibh, and Ziad Jarrah. Atta disappeared from Germany for periods of time, spending some time in Afghanistan, including several months in late 1999 and early 2000 when he met Osama bin Laden and other top al-Qaeda leaders. But now let's see what really happened there in Afghanistan. Iranians and Afghans both speak Farsi, some speak Farsi Pashto, and the others speak Dari (in addition to a distinctive group of the Turkic speaking peoples only with their own beliefs, living in Tehran and Azerbaijan). In this desert a series of meetings occurred in spring of 1999, involving Khalid Sheikh Mohammed, and Osama bin Laden. Sayyid Qutb, one of the earlier famous figures in Islam, had made an important role in issuing fatwas of jihad against the west, until he was executed in Egypt. Hassan Nasrallah as a supportive figures of Iran (one of the most important Iranian military figures in Levant) was engaged with Islamic schools in Mashhad. Abu Musab al-Zarqawi (even until 2003 or so) was getting supported by the Iranian government and those who are called Mahdawiun by name. He was killed on June 7, 2006 when the United States dropped a bomb on a place where he was inside.[5] Meanwhile Daesh [known as IS in Syria, ISIL, or ISIS] headquarters in the Syrian town of Deir ez-Zor were attacked by the Iranian government and its possessions fatally in June 2017.[4] By the other hand, we are fighting to bring freedom to Syria as a very critical location; Afghanistan and Iraq are very strategic countries in fact in the Middle East too. Some countries are supporting terrorism. And above all, on the days of the incident the attackers were receiving strong support by western oppositions. Islamism in Europe had made strong connections with some radical Arabs. Divines were playing golf in Europe. Suicide attacks have occurred throughout history, often as part of a military campaign such as the Japanese Kamikaze pilots of World War II. To give you a little more information, anthropologist Scott Atran states "since 2004 the overwhelming majority of bombers have been motivated by the ideology of Islamist martyrdom". Following the Aceh War, and then World War II, the legacy of giving company towards constitution of some reforms were sensible. A martyr Humam Khalil Abu-Mulal al-Balawi, at Khost Afghanistan, killed 7 officers. Insurgents are killing those people who they are not believe in their ideologies. And regarding the current issue, it (Shahadat; jihad; and suicide attacks) was thought to a broader group (some kind of military troops) by some virtual faces of Islam before.[3][1] Now, over such discipline that we could make in our nation, alongside doing our daily business, and making unique trips to Bandelier natural parks, and after deadly incidents giving our condolences to the loved ones of individuals who died in service to our country, and remembering and praising those who died to protect our freedoms, we shall also better establish our appropriate type of homeland security for the United States. In philosophical-historical literatures another form of suicide mission (Fedayeen) was seen to be done by some Iranian famous characters alike the late 7th Pasdaran Brigade. So, even in Europe attackers were getting supported by western oppositions. And for example the al-Quds

Mosque in Hamburg was not such an exception. There some attackers attended and met one another, forming the Hamburg cell. The mosque opened in 1993, and was run by the Taiba German-Arab Cultural Association. It occupied a three-story building near the Hamburg Hauptbahnhof rail station in a red-light district, in the St. Georg section of Hamburg.

Now we are also trying to put heavy sanctions on terrorists those who are killing thousands of people by Iranians financial support. The FBI is after terrorists such as Ramadan Abdullah Mohammad Shallah. Prior to the Syrian war, Iran had between 2,000 and 3,000 IRGC officers stationed in Syria, helping to train local troops and managing supply routes of arms and money to neighboring Lebanon. The Quds Force is a special forces unit of Iran's Revolutionary Guards responsible for their extraterritorial operations. But I would like to add the racism mind mapping systems is a little bit different than what civilians usually imagine. Based on a broad range of psychoanalysis, the government were formed by ninety nine percent and a half positive votes of the (as I can say, usually youth and eager) leftist and rightist population. These terrorists had anti-imperialistic ideologies (around Palestine and Mediterranean Sea). And they were trying to gain authority over Al-Aqsa Mosque (we are not discussing about whatever it is the Iranian government's ideology even whether capitalism or not). Afterwards a few members of the Bin Laden's family were assaulted too.

After the eruption of the second Palestinian intifada, in September 2000 after the collapse of Middle East peace talks at Camp David, Arafat released imprisoned Hamas and Islamic Jihad militants, a decision that restored the relations between Iran and the Palestinian National Authority. The renewed support became evident when Israeli commandos captured the Karine A in 2002, a ship carrying 50 tons of advanced weaponry from Iran to Gaza. Iran had fought with Iraq over the eight-year war before. Nevertheless military units of Mujahedin-e-Khalq (PMOI or MEK)[8] and also supporters of Saddam Hussein and Ba'athist Iraq from the west, and supporters of jihad and the Taliban (a close friend of al Qaeda) and other militias from the east were threatening Iranians, application of Islamic thesis about jihad around the world was necessary for these countries. However Admiral Ali Shamkhani, Ghorbanali Dorri-Najafabadi, and Ali Younesi had a great role over the attack. The Ba'athist Iraq supported the attackers too. During Operation Iraqi Freedom, the coalition forces bombed several PMOI bases. Today, the term "Apocalypse" is commonly used in reference to any prophetic revelation or so-called end time scenario, or to the end of the world in general. Islamic apocalyptic literature describing Armageddon

is often known as fitna, Al-Malhama Al-Kubra (The Great Massacre), or ghaybah in Shī'a Islam. When we bloody jump to perish the disordered hazardous dreams of the enemy of our guardian they are publics who decide. Maybe we can say, terrorists had their semi-sporadic ambitions to attack the American soil, except the ambition of jihad. Between them the ideology of racism was that they put Afghan and Iraqi people in a state of chaos, feeding false information, and cause a feeling of hatred for them.[7] Now we are confronted by the issue that a lot of people die in these countries that their people had mild affections toward supporting the act of jihad. So it happened by the way by the cruel personnel of al-Qaeda as the CIA informs and not by these civilians. Set aside, Non-Asian minority sometimes left us the worst exceptional challenge, a million dollar challenge, for white American people. We lost at some of 343 firefighters over the service. And a noticeable part of the attack was partially coordinated in the American Soil by the enemy. Until we feel security you will be our targets and until you stop the bombing, gassing, imprisonment and torture of my people we will not stop this fight. We are at war and I am a soldier. Now you too will taste the reality of this situation." Now in the Middle East it's our turning point towards the victory, but currently we need destruction of thousands of arms for jihad and suicide bombers especially in Levant and Europe. Currently in some countries a joint group of attackers (alike some "angles of cruelty" in our farms) need a joint commissioner to solve their issues, or even the issues such as Arab insurgencies in Israel. Beside the terror attacks, after a while the Iranian government made restriction on several illegal apps being taken in Iran's cyber network, a same thing happened about several institutes right there, they have already made local proxy for the workers and made massive censorship there. Cell phones are seriously popular there. In Iran, terrorist organizations use Amazon, Wikipedia, arxiv, Academia, and Britannica also. After they received some centrifuges from Russia several years ago, now TESA of Iran is the main provider of their centrifuges. Iran was went under sanctions for oil industries and smart engines, but as terrorists didn't went out of the gold reserves, they followed theirs assassination plans. Even though it was in fire, and was gone down without humanity, there wasn't signs of hopelessness in our vision. Even though there is a distinctive sensation,

which is kept bursting with pride in halo, and in shining love. In March 2013, the United States began a series of secret bilateral talks with Iranian officials in Oman, led by William Joseph Burns and Jake Sullivan on the American side and Ali Asghar Khaji on the Iranian side, in regard with the Middle East issues and the Iranian nuclear program. But we know, proudly, if we believe we can, we can. In every terrible situation, we have fought for security of every citizen of our nation. Thus our struggles went forward towards the implementation of our outlying ambitions around the Red Sea without any divesting after comes as just it's a deal of all hell broke loose for our grandchild. Years after the attacks, a memorial was built in New York City. In addition to the one at Ground Zero, a number of other memorials have been built across the United States. Such as Flight 93 National Memorial, and Pentagon Memorial. Construction of the National September 11 Memorial & Museum began in August 2006. And it was opened to the general public in 2014.
