

## What is the Ultimate Outcome?

The ultimate outcome of Prime Minister Theresa May's parliamentary referendum -- that seeks to finalize the Brexit, is not the ultimate decision. Instead the European nation-states set into motion the collapse of the conservative majority in the House of Commons and Theresa May's prime ministership at 10 Downing Street.

To put the United Kingdom (U.K.) and the Commonwealth of Nations into perspective with the European Union (E.U.). To protect the integrity of the European common market -- set forth after the bloodshed of the Second World War. And to relegitimize the aristocratic order (essential to federalism and much of the traditional culture of the nation-state).

The ultimate outcome is not the future of the U.K. and the Commonwealth. Not whether Theresa May faces a vote of no-confidence in the House of Commons. Rather it's a humiliating decision that the U.K. learns to accept. A humiliating decision that the remaining E.U. member states set forth to forestall any lasting damage from the Brexit-vote and to uphold the norms of the European democratic tradition. Least the consequences are severe but punitive.
