<u>A STUDY IN RELATIVE INERTIAL REFERENCE FRAMES:</u>

THE PERIHELION OF MERCURY

<u>Part One</u>

The Capellan system of Heraclides of Pontus <u>predicts</u> a "virtual" Precession of the Perihelion of Mercury. The eccentricity of the orbit of Mercury is <u>predicted</u> by the translation of the Sun through space. Since this translation is circular in nature, a "virtual" Precession of the Perihelion of Mercury is <u>predicted</u>.

Before we dismiss Newtonian Celestial Mechanics that is based on Varahimihira's Universal Gravitation Model, let us note the German physics instructor who published his solution in the years of 1898 and 1902 (republished in 1917). His name is Paul Gerber (1854 – 1909).

In hindsight, we say "I should have noticed the yellow flags of caution and the red flags of danger." In 1916, Einstein claimed that his newest theory solved the mystery of the Precession of the Perihelion of Mercury. It is similar to Edwin Hubble discovering what he was <u>NOT</u> looking for. Hindsight is 20/20.

What is the Precession of the Perihelion of Mercury? Any eccentric/elliptical orbit has an Aphelion and a Perihelion. The Aphelion is the farthest distance from the center. The Perihelion is the shortest distance from the center. The Perihelion "advances" with each orbit. This is Precession.

How does this advancing Perihelion "advance"? It advances by arc degrees and it is circular in nature. In the Capellan System of the Heraclidean Model, it is a threebody problem and all three bodies are translating in circles. It resembles a carrot dangling before the eyes of a stubborn mule. The mule sees the carrot and advances toward it...except the carrot is dangling from a pole that is affixed to the mule. The carrot must move when the mule moves. The carrot (Mercury) and the mule (the Sun) remain in a constant relationship. So, the issue is in Relative Inertial Reference Frames. Einstein was correct in principle, but even a stopped clock is right twice a day.

In the Heraclidean Model, the observer on Earth is perceiving a different Inertial Reference Frame that is circling the observer. The observer is <u>perceiving</u> the "virtual" Precession of the Perihelion of the orbit of Mercury. For the Inertial Reference Frame of the Sun and its natural satellite (Mercury), there is no Precession.

Let's put Galileo aboard a ship under sail, then let's put Newton on an island, and then let's assign the ship to sail around the island. Let's assign Galileo on deck surrounded by an opaque barricade, and let's assign Newton to Plato's Cave on the island so Newton cannot see the circling ship and he cannot see the opaque barricade. Let Galileo toss a ball vertically and catch it on its descent, repeatedly and then let Newton see this tossed projectile. Now, let Newton publish a paper on his observations. Other scientists will flock to Plato's Cave on Newton's Island and they will confirm Newton's observations. Let's censure the people with an opposing explanation. Let's award ourselves Nobel Prizes for propaganda purposes to convey the idea of "settled science". Let's publish scientific textbooks to indoctrinate young and impressionable minds without a – pardon the pun –FRAME OF REFERENCE!!!
