The Modern "Magic Numbers" Differs Negligibly From the Original Numbers of Prof. Wigner's

Abstract: In MHCE8S modern universe theory the "magic numbers" of Eugene Wigner are mostly or almost the same.

In writing my previous note ${ }^{1}$ I realized my modern version (MHCE8S theory) of the universe had the same or nearly the same (within 1 magnitue) magic numbers that Eugene Wigner had published 8 decades (itself a magic number!) earlier.

The effects of these small differences can be studied by using a blow-up of the isotope stability graph provided in the Wikipedia article. So far I have found none.
